Cornwall's Big Fish: Basking Sharks (talk in March) and Blue Fin Tuna are in the seas around Cornwall. Learn more about these big fish with two events being held by the Helford Marine Conservation Group at Gweek Village Hall.

Saturday 24 February 2018 — Tracking Blue Fin Tuna. Blue Fin Tuna are being spotted more frequently in Cornish waters much to the excitement of marine biologists and fishermen alike. Exeter University Marine Resident Tom Horton has been working on a tagging project to understand more about the biology and distribution of these fish, and will be sharing some fascinating insights into this work.
