Mawnan WI - Last month was a very exciting and busy month for us with two community projects taking place. We collected over 400 bras for women and girls in Africa as part of our celebration of World Kindness Day and over 500 poppies were made for the Poppy Cascade which was hung in the Memorial Hall for the Remembrance Day Service to commemorate the centenary of the ending of World War 1. A really very big thank you to everyone who supported these projects.



In December we continue to be involved in activities within the community: on Monday 3rd December members plan to visit the Foodbank in Penryn; on Friday 7th December look out for our mulled wine and mince pies stall at the Christmas Lights Switch On; on Monday 10th December we are holding a Christmas Wreath Workshop to which visitors are warmly invited (there will be a small charge) - this will take place in the Memorial Hall from 1.30pm and then on Friday 14th December Mawnan WI hosts the Village Christmas Party to which everyone is invited - super refreshments will be served and the entertainment will be provided by The Suitcase Singers. This will be held in the Memorial Hall at 3 - 4.30pm. There will be no Cake, Chat and Company in December. The next one will be held on Saturday 12th January at 2.30 - 4pm in the Rendlesham Room.
